
First Ukulele songs - 2 chords - MOCKINGBIRD Key: G

This is a traditional, folk-style version of this song, played with just the two easy G and D7 chords (Level 1). It's not too fast, with predictable, well-spaced chord changesa perfect song to practise your first 2 chords.

G D7 Hush little baby, don't say a word, Papa's gonna buy you a mocking-bird. If that mocking-bird don't sing, *Starting note: $^{(=D)}$ Papa's gonna buy you a diamond ring. If that diamond ring turns brass, Papa's gonna buy you a looking glass. D7 If that looking glass gets broke, Papa's gonna buy you a billy goat. If that billy goat won't pull, Papa's gonna buy you a cart and bull. If that cart and bull turn over, Papa's gonna buy you a dog named Rover. If that dog named Rover won't bark, G Papa's gonna buy you a horse and cart. If that horse and cart fall down,

Timing- 4/4: ONE, 2+ 3+ 4+ ONE. 2+ 3+ 4+ ... Strum: DOWN, Du, Du, Du **DOWN**, Du, Du, Du ...

*<u>Starting note:</u> See the G diagram above to help you find the *first* note of the song- (in this song, it's when you sing "Hush", and the note is D). Make the chord formation with your left hand on the fingerboard, next to the "nut" (the white bar across the top of the neck), and press the strings down. Pluck the 3rd string so you can hear the note.
