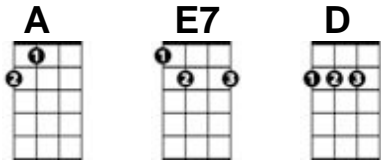


# Roll In My Sweet Baby's Arm Ricky Skaggs version
